Back in 2004 I had a chance to visit a small village in Hunan Province in China. I rode in a van with a small group up a dirt road along a river. We went until the road just got too rough, then we walked. I don't know the name of the village but let me tell you it was isolated. At no time in living memory had foreigners ever visited this place. The people were very poor, living as they had for centuries growing rice in flooded paddies.

The reason we went there was to visit a small church located in someone's home. There were crudely written hymns on the wall along with the Ten Commandments. The people crammed into the small room and sat on empty rice sacks. They were very happy to see me and the other American Pastor who came along. We were happy to see them too. We sensed a deep bond that transcended race, language and culture. We all shared the same Holy Spirit.

Interesting how the church started. A young man from the village went to study at one of China's universities. He met an American Christian who led him to Christ. The young man returned to his village and converted his parents and his sister. They in turn led about half the village to Christ.

There is a great hunger in China for the Gospel of Christ. God has been grooming them for centuries to hear and believe the Good News that Jesus took away their sin. At this time in history Chinese people are reachable. China is a long way away. But fortunately there are many Chinese people in close proximity to Trinity of Arden Hills. 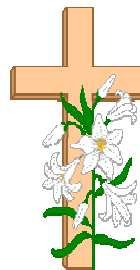
April 6 **"Hopeless"**

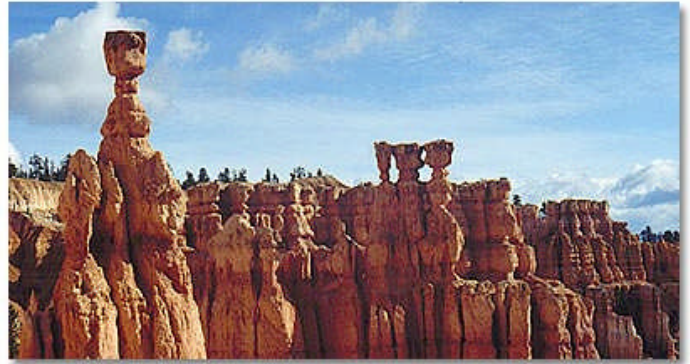

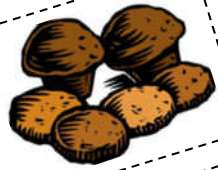
